To this end please take into account the recommendations made in the INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS which can be found in the attached program and on the ENEC Conference website.

Many of the papers received so far do not follow these instructions, not having all the required sections. It is therefore necessary to rewrite

them and for this purpose please answer to the requests of the Conferences' Secretariat.

In order not to delay too long the publication of ENEC Conference 2017 Proceedings, we urge you that until September 30, 2017 to send us the restored papers, in their final version, written in Word program and with all the requested annexes. The failure to comply the deadline automatically leads to non inclusion of those papers in the Proceedings of ENEC Conference 2017.

Most of the original articles that have been presented to ENEC Conferences are also published in the on-line journal "Hyperion International Journal of Econophysics and New Economy", edited by the Hyperion University and published with a frequency of two issues per year on the website: <http://www.journal-hyperion.ro/journal-archive>
